4.5 All Team Officials must have an O.S.A. REGISTRANT BOOK, which shall have the effective date of registration, to that specific team for that specific season, validated by the District Association. The team official is responsible for having it available at all games(including league, cup, tournament and exhibition games) for presentation. Failure to present such document shall render the team official ineligible to participate in that game, to be listed on the team sheet and to be present in team's technical area. A coach can only be registered as Head Coach for two teams.

- Team Head Coach must be registered no later than May 15th.
- Team Head Coach must have minimum children's component for B Division Teams and minimum youth component for A Division Teams
- Failure to register team head coach with the NCCP # or the required certification level shall result in a fine as set in Rules & Regulations 1(vv)
- A maximum of four (4) carded officials shall be permitted to be registered to a team and to be within the technical area. Failure to comply will result in a fine as set in Rules & Regulations 1(ww)

1(vv) The fine as it relates to Rule 4.5 is \$100 for the first game and \$50 for each subsequent game. (Team Head Coach without coaching certificate)

Any deviation from this rule will be just cause for loss of game(s) by default and/or suspension of the player or club, as determined by the discipline committee. Registration will be by a recognized form within the hands of the league: **Article 4** and **rule 6.2**. Players registered as “Competitive” with OSA playing in other league must register with this league and must state on the roster list Competitive player. The maximum number of carded players allowed per non-competitive team is a total of five per season. All Call Ups that are registered in other leagues (example in house league teams, CSL, CGSL etc.) will pay a registration fee of \$5.00 *Rules & Regulations 1(jj)* per player to be registered to play in SCYSL.

Specific Decision Requested

5.1 (legal/eligible player) All SCYSL players must have an OSA REGISTRANT BOOK, which shall have the effective date of registration, to that specific team for that specific season and validated by the District Association. Only those players properly registered with, and not under suspension by, the league may play in sanctioned games. Any deviation from this rule will be just cause for loss of game(s) by default and/or suspension of the player or club, as determined by the discipline committee. Registration will be by a recognized form within the hands of the league: **Article 4** and **rule 6.2**. Players registered as “Competitive” with OSA playing in other league must register with this league and must state on the roster list Competitive player. The maximum number of carded players allowed per non-competitive team is a total of five per season. All Call Ups that are registered in other leagues (example in house league teams, CSL, CGSL etc.) will pay a registration fee as set in *Rules & Regulations 1(jj)* per player to be registered to play in SCYSL.

Change wording as per OSA Registration Policy 3.3 a) & b - A player is registered only after their registration has been validated by the OSA’s computerized registration system as per Policy 28.0. In situations when OSA’s computerized Registration system is not working correctly, a player is registered only after their registration form has been validated by the District Association with which their Club is affiliated. The responsibility for the validation of Registration forms may not be delegated to Leagues or Clubs. (Player registration with Club, the player would be insured. The player would be ineligible to play in any OSA sanctioned games unless there was Player Registration with OSA.(Player Registration with OSA comes into effect on the next day after the player’s player registration data has been entered in to OSA’s computerized registration system.
