<b>RULE 15</b>	<b>PYC FORMAT</b>	Nov 2007
15.1	All teams will participate in the President Youth Cup Tournament. U11 and older games will start half hour earlier than regular season League games unless game is played on fields with lights.	Nov 2007
15.2	Dates for the PYC Rounds will be set in January at the Board Meeting. Host for the Finals will be selected in January. Semi Finals for the age division U9-16 will be played on the date set for the U17 & U18 Finals and the Semi Finals for the U17 & U18 will be set prior to the Finals date at a location set by the League Convenor.	
15.3	First Round – will be picked off the league schedule game report on the week that was picked in January, the game will be a league game also and count in standings as well as being the first game in PYC.	
15.4	Teams will be listed in game # order starting at the top of the Format Schedule.	
15.5	Second Round and thereafter will be sent out to Clubs with their times and location by the League Administrator.	
15.6	All games will be played regular season regulations and times for each age division.	
15.7	All games must have a winner. If the game is tie at the end of regulation teams will play an additional 2 x 10 minute halves. If still tied at the end of the 2 x 10 minute overtime halves the game will be decided by kicks from the penalty mark as per OSA rules: Procedures to Determine the Winner of a Match.	
15.8	ALL PYC GAMES will have three (3) properly registered referees per game except for the U9 and U10 as there is no offside. In the event that the game is played without the proper officials the game will not be rescheduled and the home club will be fined as set out in <i>Rules &amp; Regulations 1(ee)</i> .	Nov 2007
15.9	All First Round games will take place as a league game and home team will pay for referee and assistants like any regular league game. All games thereafter, fee will be paid by the fee structure as set out in #10 for all age divisions. .	
15.10	<p>Second Round PYC Referees will be assigned by the League. The costs are split by the participants and paid to the Referee prior to the game.</p> <p><b>U9</b> - \$20.00 a game –<b>no assistant referees needed</b></p> <p><b>U10</b> - \$25.00 a game –<b>no assistant referees needed</b></p> <p><b>U11 - U12</b> - \$60.00 a game - Referee - \$30.00 Assistant Referees \$15.00 each</p> <p><b>U13 - U14</b> - \$85.00 a game - Referee - \$35.00 Assistant Referees \$25.00 each</p> <p><b>U15 - U16</b> - \$90.00 a game - Referee - \$40.00 Assistant Referees \$25.00 each.</p> <p><b>U17 - U18</b> - \$95.00 a game - Referee - \$45.00 Assistant Referees \$25.00 each</p> <p><b>U19 &amp; up</b> - \$100.00 a game - Referee - \$50.00 Assistant Referees \$25.00 each</p> <p>Home Team is responsible for supplying the two assistant referees. League will pay for anything after second round (same pay structure as Second Round) and all three officials will be supplied by the League.</p>	Nov 2009
15.11	Third Round (Semi Finals) – This comes into effect <b>after Second Round</b> . Divisions with 3 teams left will advance to a semi final round robin format which is played on the same day as the U17- U18 finals. All 3 teams will play one game against each other. All games must have a winner. If the game is tie at the end of regulation time, teams will play an additional 2 x 10 minute halves. If still tied at the end of the 2 x 10 minute overtime halves the game will be decided by kicks from the penalty mark as per OSA rules: Procedures to Determine the Winner of a Match.	Nov 2007
15.12	All games must be played on assigned days and fields. Only the League or game referee can cancel or reschedule games. All teams must participate. Any NO SHOW, that team will default that game and be fined, the NO SHOW FEE as set out in <i>Rules &amp; Regulations 1(hh)</i> , PLUS reimburse the League in full for all referee or assistant referees fee.	
15.13	Affiliating player (call ups) to be eligible to play in the second round and following PYC games must have played at least 3 League games during the season with the team.	
15.14	Age Divisions that only have 4 teams will play a Round Robin Format – games will be marked on the game schedule as to which games these are. There is no overtime in these games – Win – 3 points, Tie – 1 point. Top two teams will advance to the finals.	
15.15	At all PYC games, players books must be checked and noted on the gamesheet that player books were checked. Failure to comply will result in an automatic 20 points to be applied to the Club.
