1.0 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1.1 This registration form is ONLY to be used by persons who were registered as referees with the OSA in either 2005 or 2006. Referees who were registered in 2004 or earlier and have failed to renew their registration in the last two years are required to fill out a referee reinstatement form and send it to the referee department of the OSA.

1.2 Registration on this form includes registration for both indoor and outdoor soccer for the period from April 1, 2007 or the date received and validated by the OSA Provincial Office if after April 1st until March 31, 2008.

1.3 Registration on this form entitles you to referee sanctioned soccer games in the Province of Ontario. This includes tournament games, exhibition games, cup games, and league games. As per OSA policy, registered referees are responsible to ensure games are sanctioned prior to officiating.

1.4 Registered referees officiating sanctioned games involving players on registered teams, are covered under the OSA Insurance Programme (both accident and liability) and the OSA Discipline Programme. Registered referees officiating either unsanctioned games, unregistered players, or unregistered teams, are not covered under the OSA Insurance programmes, but will be subject to the OSA Discipline programme.

1.5 Notwithstanding 1.4 above, registered referees may referee school, college, and university teams. However, the OSA Insurance Programme will not include these games.

1.6 As the information on this registration form will be transferred to a computer, it is imperative that all information is printed clearly.

1.7 To assist Club Head Referees, we are asking that you indicate if you regularly referee with a Community Club so your name can appear on a list for use by the Club. You may, of course, referee other games outside that one Club but this additional breakdown of the referee list will reduce wasted paper and assist with planning and game appointments.

1.8 Increasingly game appointments and communication will be made using e-mail for club, district, regional, provincial, professional and national levels of the game. Please get an e-mail address now and remember once you provide this address for communication to check it once per day.

2.0 HOW DO I REGISTER TO REFEREE?

2.1 Your OSA Registrant Number should be added to the registration form. This number is printed on the outside of the envelope in which you received this form. It will speed processing if this number is clearly printed in the space provided at the top of the registration form. If you do not know your registrant number, please ensure your date of birth is listed in the space provided.

2.2 Print your first name, last name, address, apartment or unit number, city, postal code, home telephone number and date of birth and e-mail address in the space provided.

2.3 Enclose a cheque or money order made payable to "The Ontario Soccer Association".

3.0 REFEREE CLASSIFICATION

3.1 Check only ONE classification.

3.2 If you are a Class 4 Referee, taking the Upgrading Examination (Class 3), please register before April 1st, 2007 as a Class 4 Referee. You may upgrade your classification later by sending in a cheque for \$40.00 along with a note detailing your registrant number, name and date of birth.

3.3 Once you have passed the Upgrading Examination **and** you are at least 16 years of age as of April 1, 2007 you may register as a Class 3 Referee.

3.4 Renewing Class 3 Referees may officiate in youth competitive and senior games.

3.5 If you attended an Entry-Level (C4) Course, you may register as a Class 4 Referee. Class 4 Referees may referee in youth recreational games only or be an assistant referee in youth competitive games.

3.6 Any changes in referee classification must be approved by the Director of Referee Development. Requests must be submitted in writing to the OSA Provincial Office.

4.0 DEADLINE

4.1 *The deadline for early registration is March 31, 2007. Registration forms and fees submitted after April 1, 2007 will be returned unless the \$15.00 extra processing fee is included.*****

4.2 On-line referee registration is also available. All the information is posted on the OSA website at www.soccer.on.ca. A valid credit card will be required to access this service.

4.3 Indicate the amount of the cheque enclosed. This amount should correspond to the box you have checked to indicate your referee classification. Please submit your registration fee now to avoid the extra \$15.00 processing fee.

4.4 The fee for FIFA, National, Class 1 (Nominated National), Class 1 and Class 2 referees includes the fee for one required maintenance assessment. Fees for other assessments must be submitted separately with assessment request forms. The maintenance assessment fee remains at \$50.00 for the 2007 season.

4.5 The fee for FIFA, National, and Class 1 (Nominated National) referees includes the \$100.00 registration fee to the C.S.A.

4.6 Referee registration lists may be viewed by the District Association Offices on-line and only those referees registered after April 1st may receive game appointments. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in disciplinary action.

5.0 SIGNATURE OF REFEREE

5.1 Read the NOTICE OF WARNING before you sign the form.

5.2 You must sign the registration form before it can be processed. By signing the form, you are stating that you have read and understand the registration rules and you are agreeing to abide by the Published Rules and Policies of The Ontario Soccer Association. In addition you are verifying that all the information is accurate and any falsifying or withholding of information may result in disciplinary action.

5.3 Copies of the OSA Published Rules have been distributed to your District Association and are available on the OSA Internet at www.soccer.on.ca.
